## Six Juicy JV Criteria



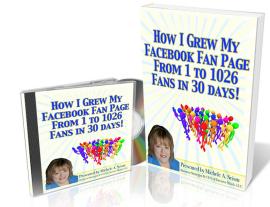
#### **#1 Aligned on a BIG PICTURE Message**

#### **#4 Affiliate Program**

- Professional
- Transparent
- Affiliate can track their own statistics... links clicked, sales
- Generous split





#### **#5 Social Media Savvy**

Connecting with others is a skill set that is highly valuable in growing your business, especially with Joint Ventures.

Here are 5 signposts that you're playing with a social media savvy partner:

- 1. Share valuable content, their own and their colleagues.
- 2. Liberally apply the 3 R's of Social Media Relate, Reveal, Relish.
- 3. Make **personal connections** with Friends.
- 4. Have **real time discussions** and conversations.
- 5. Use the **80/20 rule** 80% share, 20% self promote.













#### #6 You Are A True Fan
